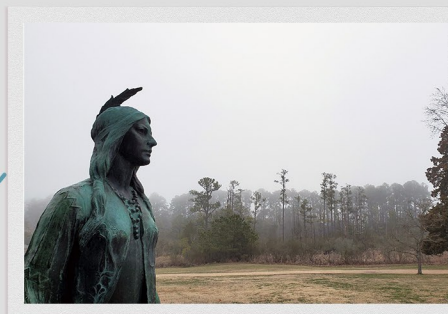
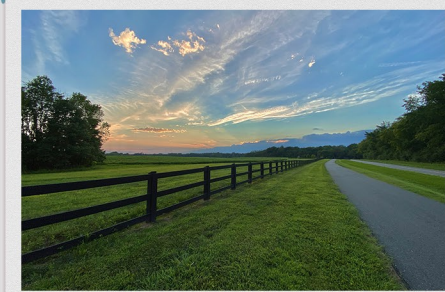

Capital Trail

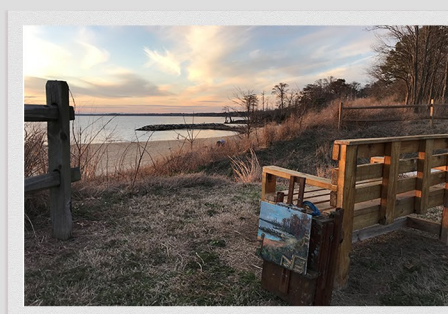
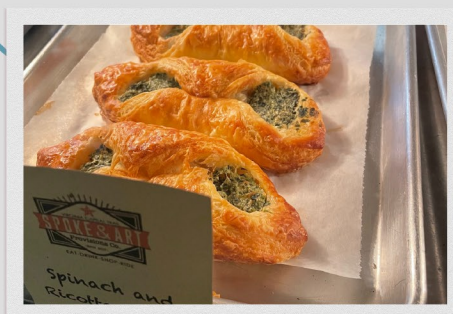
MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

Expert staff are on-site daily, leading educational tours and answering questions about the latest archaeological finds. As you tour the site, be sure to investigate the partial reconstruction of the 1608 church and stand in the same spot where Pocahontas and John Rolfe were married in 1614.
